\$500,000 FELLOWSHIP HALL

Beautifully decorated including a fireplace and player grand piano, the fellowship hall is among the most inviting and serene rooms offered in the Family Lodge for families to gather.



\$250,000 LIBRARY

The library, which holds thousands of books and magazines donated by generous individuals, is a focal point of the Family Lodge, providing a comfortable environment for reading and quiet time.



\$100,000 BUSINESS CENTER

Conveniently equipped with computer technology and WiFi, the business center is frequently used throughout the day and is designed to help families keep in touch while away from home.



\$100,000 DINING ROOM

A central location of Family Lodge activity, the dining room provides an opportunity for families to come together at meal times and throughout the day.



\$75,000 GAZEBO

The gardens of the Family Lodge provide a peaceful environment for guest respite, including spacious gazebos for outdoor reading or other use. Two gazebos are available for naming.



\$50,000-\$25,000 GUEST ACCOMODATIONS

Accommodations offer a home-like atmosphere allowing caregivers to be present while loved ones undergo extended treatments at the NIH Clinical Center. Opportunities include, first floor handicapped accessible suites, guest suites, and rooms on the first, second and third levels.



\$50,000 LOUNGES

A pleasant space comfortably furnished, where families come together for social times. Two lounges are available for naming.

A UNIQUE PARTNERSHIP



The Edmond J. Safra Family Lodge at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) offers a home-like place of respite for families and loved ones of adult patients who are receiving care at the NIH Clinical Center, the nation's premier clinical research hospital. Patients from across the nation and throughout the world visit NIH to participate as partners in medical discovery.

The Family Lodge marks its 10 Year Anniversary in 2015. The Foundation for the National Institutes of Health (FNIH) raised and coordinated funding for its original construction. The FNIH remains involved by funding breakfast for guests, along with holiday dinners and Tracy's Toy Box, which provides toys and children's items to younger guests.

The FNIH actively seeks support and accepts donations for the Family Lodge, including those from grateful families. Gifts of any size are vital to maintaining this much-needed refuge for family members and caregivers of patients receiving treatment.

All donations are fully tax-deductible. Donors who wish to name a particular space will be acknowledged with a plaque at the assigned site.

\$25,000 KIDS AREA

The area beside the kitchen offers kid friendly engagement including a flat screen television, video games, and other features, while parents are preparing meals for family night.



\$15,000 STAFF LOUNGE

The dedicated staff members of the Family Lodge are a valuable resource to families during their stay. This is an opportunity to name the staff lounge in recognition of their dedication.



\$10,000 GARDEN BENCH

Benches in the Family Lodge Garden provide a peaceful and tranquil place to relax and enjoy the beautiful Family Lodge grounds.



\$10,000 SERVICE ANIMAL EXERCISE SPACE

Name the service animal exercise space, which is a crucial area for guests with special needs and their animal companions.



\$7,500 LAUNDRY ROOM

For guests with extended stays, the laundry room provides them the opportunity to launder clothing as needed. Two laundry rooms are available for naming.



\$5,000 PRIVATE TELECOMMUNICATION ROOM

There are often multiple family members sharing a guest room. This space provides the opportunity for private conversations. There are two telecommunications rooms available for naming.
